

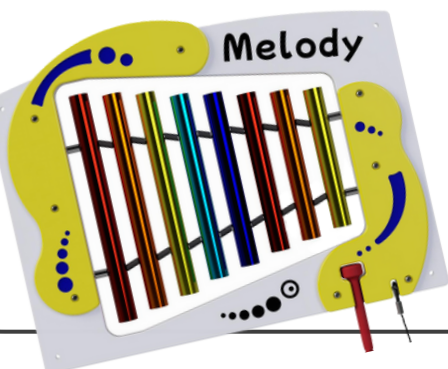


THE IMPORTANCE OF MUSIC
